

Remains Buried In Mt. Carmel Cemetery, Near Rudyville.

Brownsville, Ky., June 17.—(Special.) —The funeral rites and G. A. R. exercises at the grave of Maj. A. G. Hamilton, the veteran ex-soldier of Libby prison fame, who was recently assassinated at Morgantown, were concluded yesterday. The ex-soldier was buried at the Mount Carmel cemetery, near Rudyville. The funeral service was conducted by the Rev. Mr. Pierce, of the M. E. church. The Grand Army exercises were under the auspices of the O. P. Johnson Post of Rudyville. Maj. Hamilton, soon after the death of Capt. Johnson, organized this post and became the first commander. The posts of Morgantown, Riverside and Brownsville were also in attendance. The sermon by a comrade of Hamilton, and the exercises by the Grand Army posts were sad and impressive. An immense throng of people were present.
